

Little Wittenham, Brightwellcum-Sotwell and the Mortons

More than 12 craftspeople will be at The Sylva Wood School and Wood Centre on 18 and 19 May to discuss making furniture, boats and other items. There is a coffee shop and information on courses.

Nearby, abstract expressionist painter Liz Gascoigne is open seven of ten days in the beautiful Clumps Orchard gallery. Alongside her artwork, you can see sculptures by Ewan Shearer, who specialises in nature-based forms, historical deities and abstract shapes (plus photography). For five days, they are joined by Vivien Shelton, whose handmade ceramics explore form and texture.

Close by on 25 and 26 May, William Watkin is showing a mix of colourful abstract paintings, large and small, on canvas and paper in the industrial setting of the Old Piggery.

The White Cottage is open eight days with new artwork by award-winning landscape painter Jane Duff displayed in her new gallery space. A lovely garden and refreshments are available.

Finally, under the shadow of the Clumps, the Earth Trust is open every day but on Saturdays with a collection of artwork by local artists, including sustainable fashion and upcycled jewellery. Refreshments and family-friendly workshops are available.

The Brightwell Village Hall Artists will be open for the final four days with a collection of paintings, batiks and ceramic pots on display.

Further on, the North Moreton Artists will be in All Saints Church with a wide variety of art and design, including rocking horses, plus the opportunity for tea and homemade goodies.

Finish your trip by visiting artist Morag Conway, whose artwork contemplates nature, landscape and motherhood, at Westwards in South Moreton.

Four trails to follow

Check opening times—if no days are listed then the venue is open every day.

All venues are FREE entry.

Shillingford and Dorchester-on-Thames

Penny Astrop is one of two artists exhibiting every day except Wednesday at Vintner's Lodge, Shillingford. Her artwork includes atmospheric landscapes and figurative drawings from life and her imagination. The other artist is Robin McClelland, a potter who makes stoneware ceramics and garden sculptures, often asymmetrical and with textured surfaces.

Moving upriver to Dorchester-on-Thames, Jane Elsworth has an open studio in Queen Street at both weekends to showcase her vibrant landscape paintings and gorgeously glazed pottery.

Visit the Old Stables to see mosaics made from broken, discarded and unwanted china by Joanna Ferguson is open the first weekend and from the Friday to the end of the long weekend.

Further up the High Street, Sophia Stewart and Tamsin John are open on the same days with large watercolour landscapes (Sophia) and handmade ceramics (Tamsin) inspired by their print-making training.

Tracey Lester and Ellie Ribeiro Beaman are showing oil paintings in an impressionist style, mosaics, jewellery and greeting cards from their home around the corner on the same days. If the weather is fine, refreshments will be available in the garden.

Nuffield and Ewelme

The Maker Space will display incredible work, including textiles and jewellery, by its tutors at its modern, bright workroom in Nuffield. The popular café attached is one of the best in South Oxfordshire.

A short drive away off the A4130 is Mays Farm Studio, where nine artists create vibrant paintings in a variety of styles. 'Come and see us at work!' they promise.

Moving to Ewelme Pottery, Harriet Coleridge specialises in stoneware or porcelain pots fired with wood and carbon trap shino glazed pots. Plus wooden breadboards.

Sculptor/blacksmith Bruce Garside will have artwork on display at the pottery (also at the Tree Barn, Christmas Common).

Also on site is textile designer Mary Lowry, who will demonstrate weaving on one of her looms. She makes bespoke scarves and shawls.

Anne Payton will display a selection of stilllife oil paintings. The final artist on site, Albert Harvey, offers hand-block-printed fabrics for interiors.

Wallingford

Visit the Coach House to see Christine Bass's acrylic landscapes inspired by the Ridgeway and Chiltern Hills. Also in the venue is contemporary jeweller Kate Wilkinson, who makes statement necklaces or earrings. Record-cover designer Sophie Bass shares the space, displaying works in gouache and pen. Refreshments are available. Open every day except Wednesday.

On the Bank Holiday weekend, St Peter's Church will host the CommuniTree Art Project, where everyone can be an artist. There are two workshops on Monday.

The Wallingford Artist Showcase will display works by local artists participating in Artweeks. While it is open from Friday on the Bank Holiday weekend, the listed building also serves as the focal point for several Artwalks around the town.

Just down St Martins Street is the Potter's Wheel, a working studio and teaching space with artwork on display and for sale.

Walking towards the Kinecroft, the Wallingford and District Art Club presents its Summer Show at Centre 70 on the second Saturday and Sunday, with paintings by 20 members, including award-winner Gavin Peacock.

Also at Centre 70, artist Mark Wood offers a selection of local landscapes and figurative work for sale.

A short walk further on is Ayres House Studios, the leading local studio for professional artists and makers featuring ceramics, drawings, furniture, painting, photography, sculpture, textiles and more. Open every day except Tuesday and Wednesday, visitors can meet the artists as they work and discuss their creations.

Use the trail map to:

- 1. Meet artists and makers and find out how they work.
- 2. Buy local artwork, furniture, ornaments and tableware for your home or as a gift.
- 3. Pick convenient venues to visit for a fun day out (or afternoon).
- 4. Find out how to develop your creative talents and what help is available.
- 5. Discover more about the wonderful countryside we live in.


